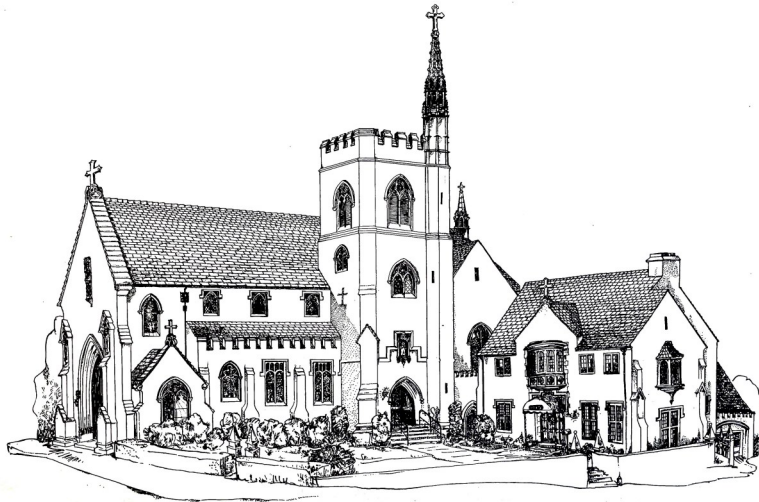

Intentions are assigned to Masses on a “first come, first served” basis. If the date you requested is already taken, we will assign your Intention to the closest Mass that is still open for Intentions. If you have no particular date in mind, that’s also acceptable. The Office will assign your Intention to an available Mass.

We can only assign Masses to dates four months ahead and not beyond.
